- Consisting of 20 member airlines
- Purchasing Jet fuel through a yearly tender and through bilateral negotiations where the market is monopolistic
- Covering the fuel requirements at the following regions: Africa, Europe, Middle East,
  Far East, Canada, Americas, Australia and Gulf for the contractual period from 1<sup>st</sup>
  January till 31 December.
- The project aims at reducing the cost of purchasing fuel in order to consummate profitable savings.



# ☐ **Joint Cooperation at Outstations**The objective of the project is to maintain and enhance the quality of services delivered to member airlines at outstations while addressing cost issues, as well as improving the contractual terms with various service providers.

The current Joint Ground Handling Agreements are with HAVAS in Istanbul and 20 other Turkish airports and with Aviapartner Italy in Rome. The Board is constantly working on expanding the project to cover more stations as well.

#### ☐ AACO Regional Training Centers

Offering training services at a cost effective price through a regional training center in Amman and a branch in Cairo, organizing annually a scheduled program for training course to be conducted at more than 5 major cities in the Middle East. AACO training centers as well provide In-house Training at the Airline's home base to save time and cost, also academic programs are available in cooperation with Concordia University, Canada.
