



AACO Membership Requirements

I- Membership Qualifications

Any Arab airline may join AACO, provided it meets the following conditions:

1. To bear the nationality of one or more of the Arab states and be headquartered in one of these states.
2. To operate, under a license issued by the National Civil Aviation Authorities, air services to carry passengers, mail or cargo.
3. More than 50% of its capital to be Arab.
4. To have safety certificates of its operations recognized by the Civil Aviation Authority or other internationally recognized certificates such as the IOSA.

II- The rights and obligations of members

The right to vote is exclusively for active members. The rest of the rights and duties are to all members, including the following commitments:

1. Implementation of AACO Articles of Association
2. Work to achieve the objectives of AACO and honor the General Assembly resolutions.
3. To avoid harmful competition, and all that would harm the legitimate interests of AACO members, within the framework of applicable laws.

III. Required Documents

The application form should be completed and returned with the documents listed below:

1. A certified copy of the Air Operator's Certificate (AOC)
2. Published timetable. For non-scheduled operations, a list of destinations is requested
3. Company bylaws
4. Company's full address
5. Information about the fleet (Number & Aircraft Types and registration)
6. An audited financial statement for the past three years, if available.
7. Safety certificates recognized by the Civil Aviation Authority or other internationally recognized certificates such as the IOSA.
